
- 5. Install front auxiliary bracket, attach using: (1) 3/8" x 1 1/4" hex head bolt, (2) 3/8" flat washer, (1) 3/8" lock washer (1) 3/8" hex nut. Leave loose. See illustration 4.
- 6. Locate in the rear part of the rocker panel the big hole and place rear bracket. Once the bracket it's in correct position, mark upper hole of bracket in the rocker panel and proceed to drill the where the mark was made using: (1) 7/16" drill bit . Note: for you own safety use security glasses. See pictures 1, 2, illustration 5.
- 7. Place the rear bracket and attach with: (1) 3/8 x 1 1/4" hex head bolt, (2) 3/8" flat washer, (1) 3/8" lock washer, (1) 3/8" hex nut. By each hole of bracket. Leave loose.
- 8. Place the side bar of the brackets and attach in the rear and front part with: (1) 1/2 x 2" hex head bolt, (1) 1/2" flat and lock washers. By each bracket. Note: In the front part attach the auxiliary bracket with the same bolt. Leave loose. See illustration 6.
- 9. Align the Side bar to the vehicle and tighten all hardware.
- 10. Repeat for the other side of vehicle.
- 11. Fill out the warranty card included and place it inside your vehicle.



