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1. Before beginning the installation, please read all directions carefully and verify that all necessary hardware is accounted for. If any parts are missing, stop the installation and contact your distributor immediately.

2. To install front mounting bracket locate in the rocker panel tape covering the holes on the inside of the rocker panel and remove it. Insert into the exposed round hole (1) 1/2" bolt plate. See picture 1 & 2. (Arrow A).

a).- Remove the bolt and clip nut. See picture 2. (Arrow B).

b).- Install the front mounting bracket using corresponding hardware. Leave loose. See illustration 2.

c).- Secure front mounting bracket's face towards the floor using (1) 1/4 x 1" hex head bolt with corresponding provided hardware.

Leave loose. See Illustration 2.

3. To install front auxiliary mounting bracket locate and remove the cover tape behind the front mud guard and insert into the square hole (1) 5/16" bolt plate. See picture 3. (Arrow C).

a).- Install the front auxiliary mounting bracket using corresponding hardware. Leave loose. See illustration 2.

4. To install rear mounting bracket, locate and remove at the rocker panel the cover tape and insert into the largest round hole	(1
) 1/2" bolt plate and place into the small round hole (1) 1/2 x 2" hex head bolt. See picture 4 & 5.	
a) Install the rear mounting bracket using corresponding hardware. Leave loose. See illustration 2.

5. Place side bar to the front/rear mounting brackets and secure using (1) 1/2 x 2" hex head bolt, and (1) 1/2" flat and lock washers. **NOTE:** Using same 1/2" bolt at front secure main mounting bracket and auxiliary mounting bracket. Leave loose. **See Illustration 2.**

- 6. Align the sidebar to the vehicle and tighten all hardware.
- 7. Repeat for the other side of vehicle.
- 8. Fill out the warranty card included and place it inside your vehicle.
